It is an invitation for each of us to encounter afresh, or even for the first time, the personal love that God has for each of us, to respond and grow as disciples of Jesus Christ; becoming faith-filled, joyful and outward-looking missionary disciples through an openness to the Holy Spirit.

The Bishop hopes that we can find time, when we all encounter afresh the amazing love of God our Father in sending us his Son and ponder again on Mary's openness to receiving that love.' (Pastoral Letter, November 2018).
