REFURBISHMENT OF OUR LADY'S SACRISTY

The refurbishment of our Sacristy at Our Lady's is now under way. As a result of this we will therefore be unable to open our Church until the work is completed. We are probably looking at a completion date sometime in September. We will keep you updated on plans and progress.

EVENING ROSARY

Teresa McCoy would like us all to join in praying the Rosary every evening at 7pm. This is an opportunity for all individuals, families, religious communities and every member of the faithful to unite as a parish spiritually to create a Rosary Chain for the parish.

OPENING OF CHURCHES FOR MASS

Now that churches can open again for the celebration of Mass, unfortunately we are not in a position to open Holy Cross due to Fr John isolating. The full guidance from the Government and the Bishops' Conference has been issued. This guidance will set out the measures needed to be taken for us to open for Mass which will include a restriction on numbers in church, a cleaning regime for after each Mass, changes in how we celebrate, restrictions in how we gather and congregate afterwards. Keep a close eye on the bulletin and website for news on the opening of our churches. To

start the process and to meet the most significant requirement within the guidance issued is the requirement to have stewards in attendance. To see if it is possible for our Churches to open, please get in touch if you think you could give some time to volunteer as a steward. We can

then decide when each church could possibly open. Stewards must be known to the Parish Priest and already volunteering in the parish in some capacity (i.e as a reader, Eucharistic Minister, cleaning rota, PPC member) If you are known to the Priest, but don't already volunteer, you will have to fill out a 'New Volunteer Form' so that you can be registered as a volunteer. Stewards must not be in the clinically vulnerable categories set out here: https:// www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/people-athigher-risk/whos-at-higher-risk-from-coronavirus/ Stewards will be asked to welcome people, ensure that people stay 2m apart, control the maximum number of people in the church, ask people to use hand sanitiser, frequently clean door handles and other 'high touch' surfaces and at the end of each Mass the church must be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected. If you think you could give an hour or two each week then please email ourladysbulwell@hotmail.co.uk or call the parish office to

request a volunteer form.
