OPENING OUR CHURCHES FOR MASS

NB We have had to delay the opening of Holy Cross Church for Mass for a further week to the weekend of 12th/13th September. This is due to the strict guidelines that we need to adhere to regarding the Risk Assessment. We also have to have a team of Stewards in place who need to complete and sign volunteer forms and they need to be aware of the requests on the Risk

Assessment. We will work towards opening Holy Cross Church on the weekend of 12th/13th September for the first time in months providing all systems are in place.

Whilst the refurbishment is taking place at Our Lady's we will say Mass at Holy Cross on a Saturday Evening at 5pm and one on a Sunday morning at 9.30am. Spaces will be limited, so from the beginning of September, we will be starting to take 'bookings' if you want to come to Mass.

Please do not try to book a place before then. Details of how to book a place at Mass will be published nearer the time, so keep an eye on the parish bulletin. Spaces are limited due to social distancing, so it will be on a first-come-first-served basis and we ask that if you come to Mass one weekend, you may be placed on a waiting list for the following weekend so to give everyone a chance to come. Please spread the word so that as many people as possible know that this will be happening and how to come to Mass. **We need stewards/cleaners;** if you are under the age of 70 and don't have any underlying health conditions, please come forward NOW to volunteer to act as a steward and/or cleaner so that we can open. **The Church can only open if we have enough stewards registered.
