IICSA REPORT

The Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse released its report into the Catholic Church. The report rightly brings to light the failings and inconsistencies in the Church's application of its safeguarding procedures. It strongly criticises the lack of leadership in failing to address child sexual abuse and the delays in implementing change. In particular, the treatment of victims and survivors of abuse has been found wanting. Previous apologies from the leadership of the Church have been repeated during this inquiry ... hopefully, this time, the apologies will be reinforced by action to address the failings. At a parish level, procedures are robust and ensure that our parishes are safe places for children and vulnerable adults. If anyone experiences or has experienced abuse of any kind, they will be listened to and action will be taken, including the passing on of concerns or allegations to the statutory authorities.
