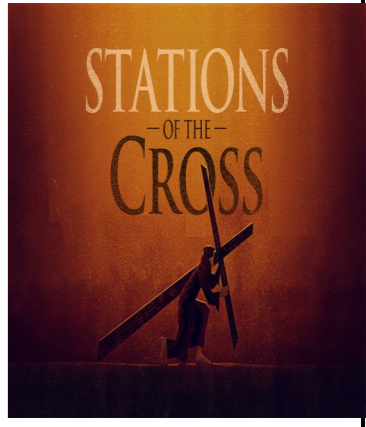

Social distancing is set at 2 metres, so please observe this as you arrive and leave the Church.
