'MUST TELL MY NEIGHBOUR' #EUTELLTHEM:

Do you know a neighbour, a friend or family member who is either an EU, EEA (includes Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) or Swiss citizen? If so, are they aware that in order for them to remain in the UK they need to complete EUSS documents and submit them to the Home Office. Some people will have lived in the UK for many years, or they may be homeless or in care and don't know that it is now the law to apply to remain here. At the Nottingham Law Centre, they can go through the paperwork with them, but they do need to call now and fix an appointment with one of their solicitors. This is free of charge and needs to be done by Wednesday 30 June 21. If you, or you anyone you know needs help with this, please call Nottingham Law Centre on 0115 978 7813.
