CELEBRATION OF HOLY MASS AT HOLY CROSS / OUR LADY'S REVISED CHANGES TO MASS AS FROM WEEKEND OF 31ST JULY AND 1ST AUGUST

The Government Places of Worship Task Force met on Monday 19th July and they produced guidance for the safe use of Catholic Churches moving forward. These guidance notes emphasise that the responsibility is now very much held at local level, understanding the local situation with the virus and its transmission (along with vaccination rates etc) and a risk assessment built around these principles. For the purpose of keeping everyone safe, as much as we possibly can, I have decided for our Parish to maintain all the present guidelines in place which are to sanitise hands on entry and exit of church, I strongly recommend to wear facemasks unless your exempt and continue to use the one way system for Holy Communion. Hands, Face, Space, Ventilate is still key. Please use track and trace when entering the church. We will no longer use the Mass Booking System and we will allow as many people as is safe to do so into the church. For the moment I would appreciate the stewards to remain in welcoming and guiding people as much as possible. We will have a certain number of seats available where cards will be available for you to place beside you if you do not wish another person to sit in close proximity to you. I ask you all for your help and cooperation in ensuring your own safety first and that of your neighbour, as the risk of infection is still very prevalent. Holy water will not yet be available in the stoups. Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. The obligation to attend Holy Mass is still suspended but we hope to be able to fulfil this most important Church precept by the First Sunday of Advent 2021.
