### **CELEBRATION OF HOLY MASS AT** HOLY CROSS / OUR LADY'S

I have decided for our Parish to maintain all the present guidelines in place which are to sanitise hands on entry and exit of church, I strongly recommend to wear facemasks. Please use track and trace when entering the church. We will no longer use the Mass Booking System and we will allow as many people as is safe to do so into the church. We will have a certain number of seats available where cards will be available for you to place beside you if you do not wish another person to sit in close proximity to you.
