SYNODAL PATHWAY 2021 MEETING

The Bishop's pastoral letter and the time line details, as well as a link to the Vatican information along with Pope Francis' address to the Synod, are now on the website.

We are holding a parish meeting on **Tuesday 23rd November at 7pm in Our Lady's Parish Hall** for parishioners from both churches to consider what a Synod is, and how we can contribute to the Synodal Process. These questions will be considered at the meeting: 1). What is our dream for the Church, for our parish/chaplaincy, so that it can become more outward-looking, more missionary? 2). To achieve this dream, what do we need to stop doing? What are we doing that needs to be developed or done differently? **For those unable to join our parish meeting you can submit your responses to the parish questions online by visiting www.dioceseofnottingham.uk/synod2023 and clicking on 'HAVE YOUR SAY'. The information submitted will feed into our own parish reflections. This form can also be used by those on the margins of the Church or who are not a Catholic.
