THE POOR CLARE SISTERS

have been in residence at the Monastery in Bulwell since 1927. In 2018 an additional community of sisters from North Wales moved here. The Monastery is in poor repair and has significant problems, to the extent that it became uninhabitable and the community moved out in 2021. The sisters are currently dispersed to three properties (two are owned by the diocese and one by another religious order) until more suitable accommodation can be arranged for the community as a whole. The sisters have undertaken significant fundraising which will make a major contribution to the cost of providing more suitable accommodation. The possibility of refurbishing or building a new monastery on the existing site is complicated by the difficulty of proving ownership under the terms of the original Deed of Trust. We will keep all informed of developments.
