SCHOOL ADMISSIONS TO CATHOLIC SECONDARY ACADEMIES (YEAR 7) - CHILDREN BORN BETWEEN 01/09/2011 AND 31/08 2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is **31st October 2022.**

Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a 'faith criterion' you must also complete a *supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **MUST** also include the supporting evidence as required e.g baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable) with this form. Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of getting a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
