For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a 'faith criterion' you must also complete a *supplementary information form,* and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required e.g baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable) with this form. Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of getting a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
