Christmas Message from Fr. Richard - 2023

My sisters and brothers in Christ,

As we gather at this most special time of year, we rejoice as we celebrate the birth of our saviour, Jesus Christ, the Word made flesh.

"In the beginning was the Word. The Word was with God and the Word was God"

During Advent, we have reflected on the prophecies of the ancient prophets who foretold the coming of the Messiah, the one who would set his people free, the one who would save us from our sins. John the Baptist, the last of the prophets, prepared a way for the Lord and rejoiced to see his appearing. John is the voice that cries in the wilderness, not a physical wilderness, but the wilderness of apathy and unbelief in the hearts of men and women. But what good is a voice without a word?
